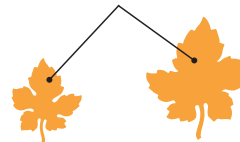

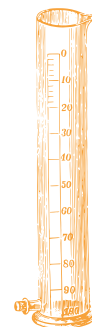

An agreeable and forthcoming nose offers notes of tobacco and fresh mint. Extremely well balanced, our 1995 has a wonderful attack and a real power to it. On the palate, the wine is round and still possesses freshness despite its age. It slowly but surely opens up, leading to a finish with remarkable finesse.

We would recommend opening the wine and decanting prior to tasting.
