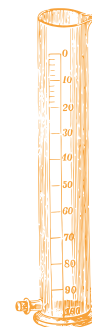

### TASTING NOTES IN 2015

This wine has an intense, attractive and well-rounded first nose - similar to our 2009, 10 years its elder - with aromas of coffee and chocolate. The attack is agreeable and tannic with a balanced mid-palate offering notes of port, cherry liqueur and cognac. A round mouth-feel displaying aromas of licorice and spices, with a long, warm finish.
