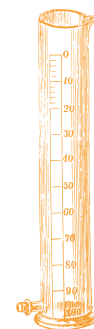

TASTING NOTES IN 2015

This wine has an intense colour with an expressive, rich nose with notes of woodland flora, autumn leaves and dried rose petals. The attack is fine and fresh, slightly sweet with velvety tannins. The wine is powerful, with an excellent structure and tightness in the mouth. The finish is soft, subtle and balanced. This wine's tannins keep us enthralled until the very end.

We would recommend opening the wine and decanting prior to tasting.
