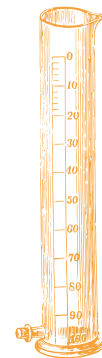

A few months after bottling, Les Pèlerins de Lafon-Rochet 2015 shows a very good balance with a nice tannic structure and a good freshness. Taste of good fresh fruit, cherry and blackcurrant and notes of cedar and white pepper.

This wine is typical of the Saint Estèphe appellation and will open up to become even more enjoyable in the years to come.
